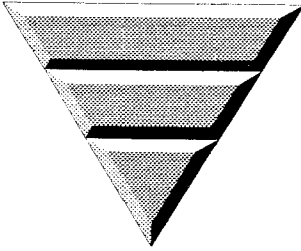


**APHA is just weeks away!!

Annual Dinner Event!

This year's event will be Wednesday night, November 20 at the CLAIRE RESTAURANT in Chelsea. Claire was opened by Marvin Paige in Key West almost 20 years ago, and has been in New York for almost 15 years. The atmosphere is tropical, casual, and funky, and the menu is a wild ride through the Caribbean, Thailand and New Orleans. Claire is a short trip by cab from the convention hotels.

Dinner includes:

- Penne Primavera with fresh seasonal vegetables
- Linguini with shrimp in a fresh marinara sauce.

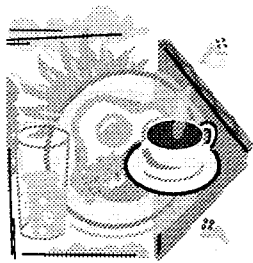

Women's Breakfast

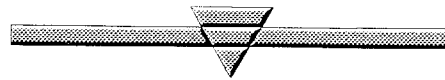

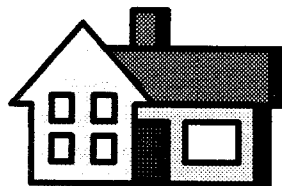


VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!!!
